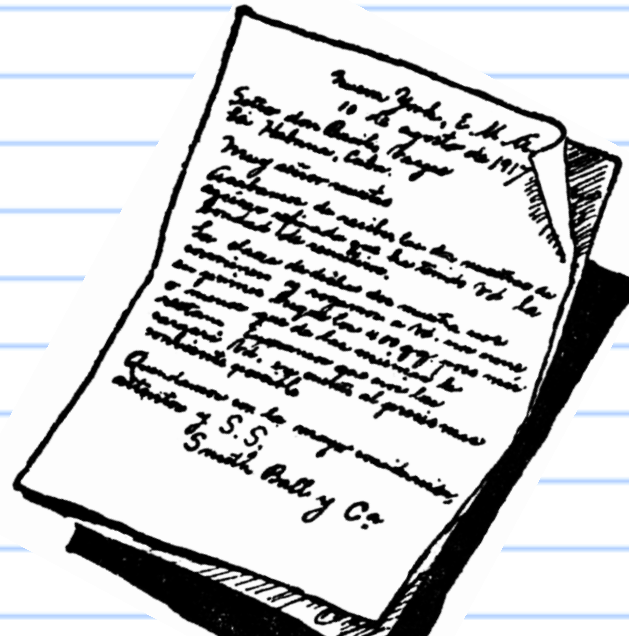

# An Introduction to Digital Portfolios

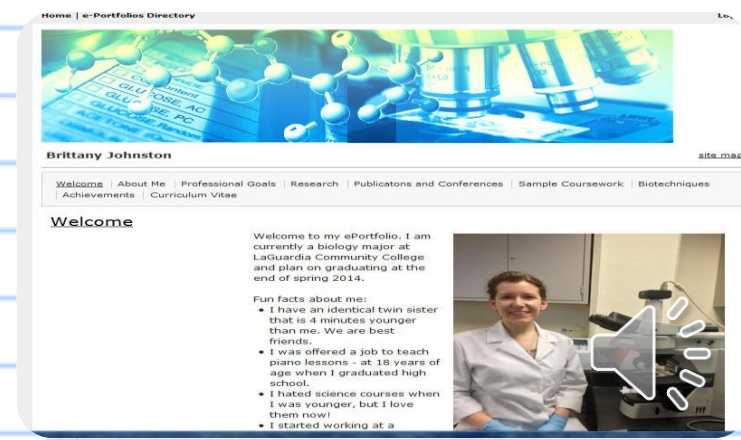
## Overview:

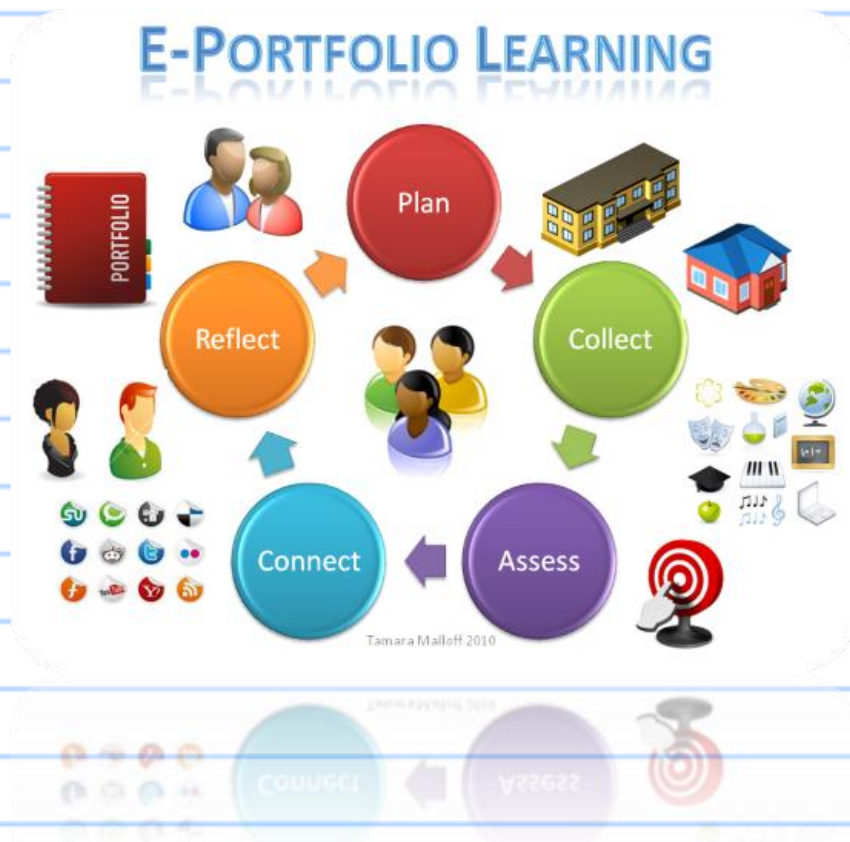

# An Introduction to Digital Portfolios

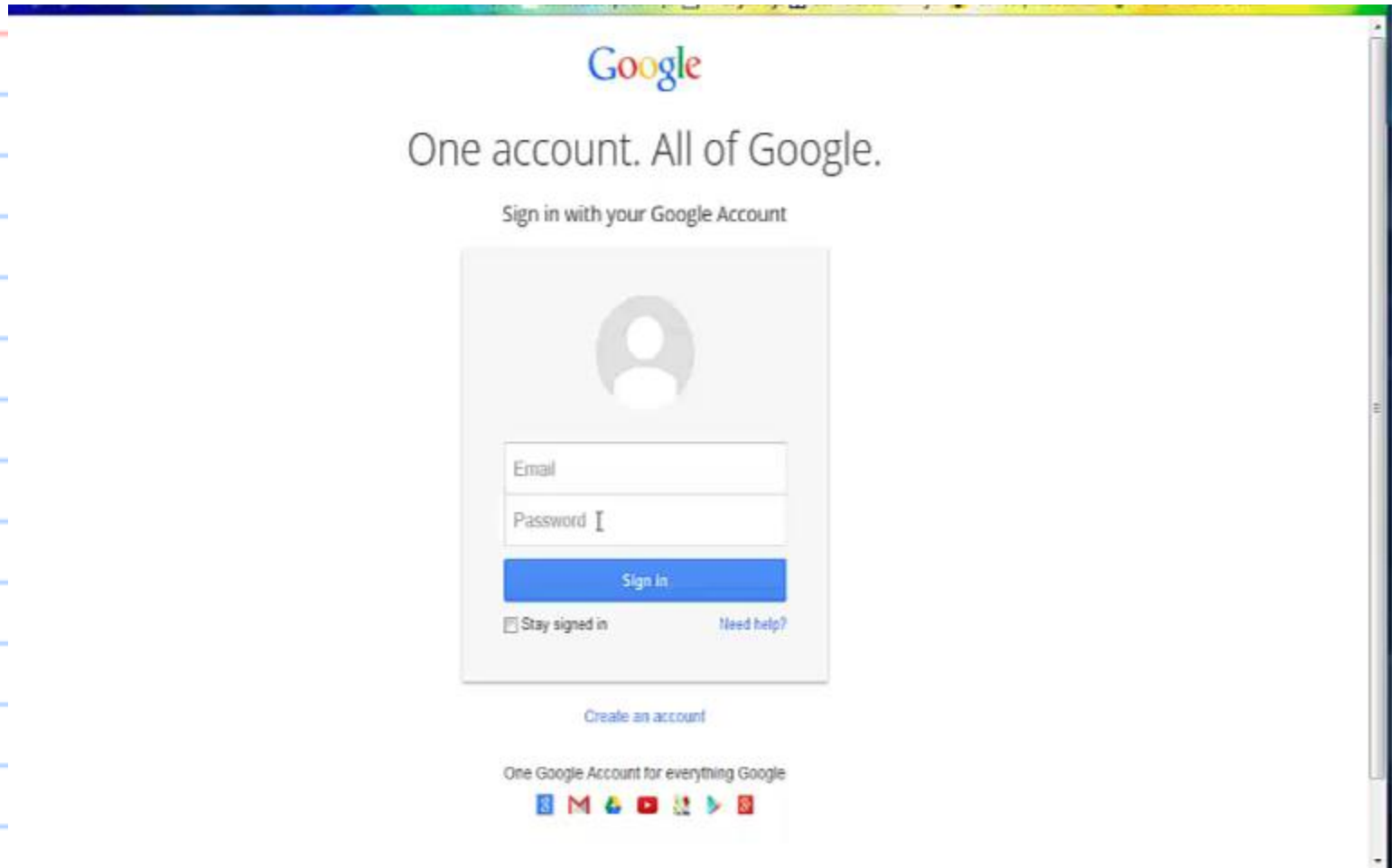
